Homework

- All the children at HCJS are encouraged to read aloud to an adult at home. We would ask that you aim for 5 times a week (2dojos!) 3 times a week earns a child 1dojo. We ask that an adult sign the reading record each time you have heard your child read. We aim to check Reading records on a weekly basis.
- Spellings
- Homework is set every half-term after the first half-term settling in period. It comes in the form of a grid of subject related activities from which the children choose a specified number for that half-term.
- We have a Homework Showcase at the end of each half term where your children can 'show off' their favourite piece of work.
- In addition to the hard copy in red homework books, Homework will be set on Google Classroom. (+ logins/passwords, spellings)
