



HOME – SCHOOL AGREEMENT

As a school

We will:

- Provide a broad, balanced curriculum aligned with National Curriculum Key Stage 2 requirements.
- Share curriculum plans to ensure transparency in teaching objectives.
- Foster high academic standards through collaboration, care, and new opportunities.
- Establish clear routines to support learning and behaviour.
- Support your child's wellbeing and safety by providing a safe, supportive and caring environment.
- Promote positive behaviour and the 'Ready, Respectful & Safe' rules through warmth, praise, and reinforcement.
- Encourage children to always do their best and show respect for others, their property, and their surroundings.
- Use child-friendly language and restorative conversations to manage behaviour effectively.
- Maintain regular communication with parents about progress, concerns, attendance, and other school matters.
- Address complaints in accordance with the school complaints policy.
- Build strong relationships with pupils and handle behaviour concerns privately and calmly.
- Follow up on incidents with conflict resolution and parental communication as needed.
- Encourage good attendance and address any concerns with parents or carers where necessary.
- Reserve the right to conduct **home visit welfare checks**, in accordance with our statutory safeguarding duties under the Children Act 1989 and Keeping Children Safe in Education, if a pupil is absent without explanation and we are unable to establish their whereabouts.
- Respond to communications from parents within school office hours, in accordance with school policies.

Parents/carers

I will do my best to:

- Prioritise my child's education and well-being.
- Ensure my child attends school regularly and on time. Inform the school by 9am if your child will be absent or late, ensuring clear and timely communication for safety.
- Ensure my child is dressed in the correct uniform, and they are prepared for the school day including provision of equipment such as weather appropriate clothing, PE kit, water bottle and stationary.
- Encourage my child to try their best so they can reach their full potential.
- Attend parents' evenings and meetings regarding their child's progress, learning, and behaviour. Working together with the school to achieve the best outcomes for my child.
- Support the school to make sure my child maintains a consistently high standard of behaviour. Support the school's behaviour policies, including attending relevant meetings.
- Model and reinforce the school's values and 'Ready, Respectful, Safe' rules.
- Communicate to the school any concerns that I have about my child that may affect their behaviour in school or ability to learn.
- Ensure communication with the school is respectful, and that I make every reasonable effort to address my communications to the appropriate member of staff. Discussing concerns privately, away from children.
- Understand that I should communicate with staff during school office hours, and although they may at times respond outside of those hours, I can't always expect that.
- Encourage home learning by reading aloud with their child (aiming for five times per week) and supporting homework in line with the school's policy
- Read and follow the school's policies.
- Read all communications sent home by the school and respond where necessary.
- Support the school's policies on the appropriate use of mobile technology and social media, including not sharing images or information about pupils or staff online, and modelling respectful digital behaviour to my child in line with the school's expectations.
- Provide my child with a healthy snack and lunch, understanding that we are NO NUT school.

I will do my best to:

- Attend school regularly and on time.
- Wear the correct school uniform and maintain a tidy appearance.
- Bring all necessary, named equipment each day.
- Put in their best effort in classwork and homework.
- Follow school rules, especially those related to safety and behaviour.

- Take responsibility for keeping the school clean, tidy, and free from litter or graffiti.
