

Dear Parents,

This document should give you an overview of what HCJS offers to you and your child to ensure a smooth transition from infant school to junior school.

Before National Offer Day

We host an Open Day & Evening in the Autumn term, usually in late October, early November. This is your first chance to meet all teaching staff, get a feel for the school, its geography, vision values and approach to education.

The Bucks Primary admission portal opens in November and closes in January.

Once you have chosen our school, you will find out whether you have been successful on National Offer Day in April. We call this our 1st round of allocations. At this point our transition provision fully begins and we start to plan for the arrival of your child.
